1 12 in. ruler with inches and cm.

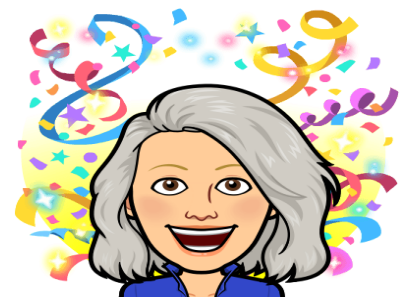
1 pair of scissors
